Your salesman may negotiate your commission rate depending on the type and amount of consignments. In signing the auction contract, you agree that Jeff Martin Auctioneers reserves the right to decide the sequence, location, and day your items will sell. Box 16809 Hattiesburg, MS 39404. **Please note Jeff Martin Auctioneers does not pay the seller/consignor for any items not paid for by the auction buyer.**
 - **Listing Sheets:** Please submit listing sheets for each item consigned and use a separate sheet for each item. We have provided a copy of the different listing sheets with this packet for your convenience. Titled items: Copies of the front & back of the title must accompany the listing sheet. If you assign asset numbers to your items as a part of your inventory tracking system, please include this number on the listing sheet. Please note the brochure and catalog deadlines above. An equipment list may be submitted via excel file or the listing sheets can be emailed to florida@jeffmartinauctioneers.com or sent via fax: 407-749-6516.
 - **Pictures:** Please submit any pictures you would like to use in jpeg format to florida@jeffmartinauctioneers.com. Please reference the make, model, and serial number of each picture along with your complete seller's information.

Equipment Detail & Repair: Equipment should be in sale ready condition prior to arrival. In our experience, sale ready equipment will bring higher net value results to you, the seller. Sellers may have their mechanics work on their machines, however, proper paperwork (i.e. proof of insurance) must be obtained by the office before entry on Jeff Martin Auctioneers auction site. We will have one qualified mechanic provided onsite with all necessary tools and equipment.

- **Equipment Delivery:** The auction site will open January 2nd 2020. A unique identification number will be assigned by Jeff Martin Auctioneers for each item that is brought to our auction site. Your trucking company must know the name, address, and phone number for the seller of the items bring delivered. If the load is mixed with another seller's items, the driver must know which items belong to which seller. Please keep all delivery/shipping documentation provided by the trucking company as proof of delivery. A Jeff Martin Auctioneers employee can sign off on your shipping documentation if requested, after counts are verified.
- **Keys, Manuals, and Other Information:** Two sets of keys must be provided with any rolling stock item. If two keys are not provided, deductions will be made to your net proceeds to cover the cost of additional keys. Manuals should be included and delivered with the equipment. We have found items have a better return on investment when properly prepared for auction. This includes clean interior, cranking with the key (without a boost), and ample fuel to allow for demonstration by potential buyers. The potential buyer is looking for the same things you look for when you are a buyer. **Jeff Martin Auctioneers will charge \$8.00 per gallon to provide fuel.**
- **Miscellaneous and Other Parts:** Any miscellaneous or parts item consigned must have a description of the item attached. Please have the small miscellaneous items secured to a pallet to help prevent loss and damage. There may be additional information or requirements, so be sure to ask your salesperson for details.
- **Titles:** Please provide a copy of the front & back of each title, for each titled item consigned, with the listing sheets. Original titles need to be in hand at the title office by February 3th, 2020. Please do not give staff at gate any titles. Please deliver titles to the office. Any titles delivered to the title office after February 3th will be charged a \$50 late fee for each title. Late fees will be deducted from net proceeds of sale. The title office must have a title in hand 24 hours prior to sale date or the item will be removed from auction. You will be responsible for fees associated with the contract to include but not limited to no sale fees and commission. Additional documentation may be required, depending upon the item.
- **Public Inspection:** All equipment should be delivered to auction site by February 1st, 2020. To prepare for public inspection & registration which will begin February 3rd, 2020. This gives us the opportunity to properly display your item on the auction site and post to online providers, Jeff Martin Online (powered by NextLot) and Proxibid.
- **Late Additions:** Items may be added to the auction after the brochure and/or catalog deadline listed above. Any item received after the catalog deadline (time permitting) will be included in a catalog addendum. Late items may be included in the online auction if all required documentation is provided. Please contact us for more information about our policy for accepting late items. Please submit any items that will be delivered after the catalog deadline to florida@jeffmartinauctioneers.com , fax to 407-749-6516 or your local salesperson .
- **Lot Verification:** When an item is delivered to our yard, it will be given a unique ID or stock number (which is different from the lot#) that is associated with your consignor profile. Once all your items are delivered to the auction site please call the office at 844-450-6200 for a complete list of your items. Check the list for accuracy in count & descriptions. Please notify us if you find a discrepancy as this is the information that will be in the catalog and on the buyer's invoice. You will be required to sign the verified list and return to us via email or fax. This will make the payment process easier to you, the seller. Please do a physical inspection of your items upon arrival to our yard to verify the equipment's delivered condition.
- **Mechanics Pass / Yard Access:** Auction site will be accessible to golf carts, gators, and ATV's only. Drivers must be at least 18 years old and agree to site rules. There will be golf carts available for rent the week of auction. Golf cart rental will be provided by Mid Florida Golf Carts (407-699-6400). Jeff Martin Auctioneers will provide shuttle service from auction parking lot to the auction site during auction week. Sellers may obtain a mechanics pass once proper documentation has been completed. This pass will be for mechanics only. Any vehicle entering

or leaving the auction site can and will be inspected. Audio and video recording is taking place at the entrance, exit, and other locations on site.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. GENERAL

- a. This Agreement is entered into by and between Seller, as set forth on page 1 of this agreement, and Jeff Martin Auctioneers, Inc. ("Auctioneer").
- b. Seller hereby retains, authorizes, and directs Auctioneer to arrange for and to conduct a public auction of the items of property described in Schedule A or items delivered to auction location not listed in Schedule A (herein referred to as the "Property").

2. SELLER'S WARRANTIES AND REPRESENTATIONS

Seller hereby represents and warrants as follows:

- a. The Property is **accurately and completely described**.
- b. Unless otherwise specified, the odometer and hour meter readings (if applicable) on all the Property is correct.
- c. Seller is the legal owner of the Property with full right and authority to sell such Property.
- d. A complete and accurate list of all parties having any claim or lien on or against the Property consigned by seller is disclosed to Auctioneer prior to sale. Except as specified in Schedule A or disclosed, the Property is **free and clear of all liens, encumbrances, or claims** by any other person or entity. Seller authorizes Auctioneer to contact any creditor or lien holder on the Property and Seller further authorizes the creditor or lien holder to release any information regarding a lien or encumbrance on the Property to Auctioneer. Auctioneer may deduct from the sale proceeds amounts necessary to release liens, claims, or other encumbrances on or against the equipment. If proceeds are insufficient to obtain releases, seller will immediately pay the additional amount necessary. Any liens, encumbrances, or claims not disclosed by seller to auctioneer will be considered an intentional act of fraud and auctioneer reserves the right to pursue legal prosecution for fraud.

3. ADDITIONAL DUTIES OF SELLER

- d. Seller agrees to pay all costs, including, but not limited to, attorney fees incurred by Auctioneer should any action need be taken by Auctioneer to enforce the terms of this agreement.
